

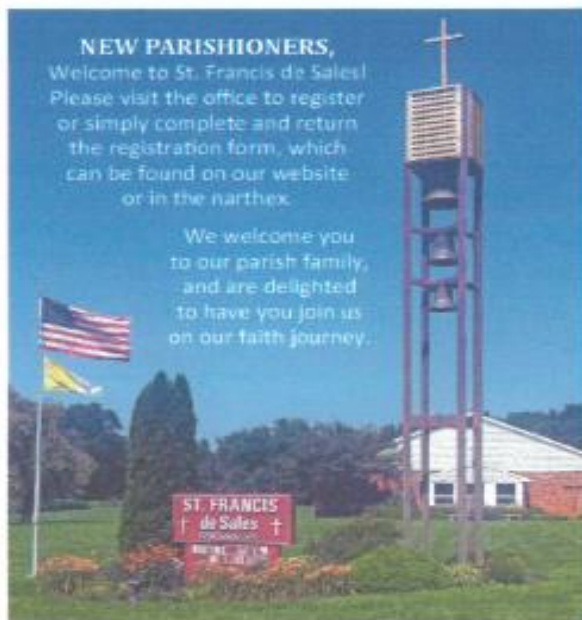

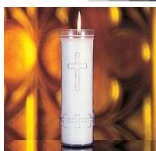

OUTREACH MINISTRY

The Outreach Ministry would like to thank the generous parishioners of St. Francis de Sales for their contribution to the St. Vincent de Paul Society collection last month. Your generosity on the 5th weekend of the month allows us to continue to help those in need and the homeless in Berks County.

We also help the community by cooking and serving meals at Kennedy House {located at 532 Spruce Street, Reading} 3 weekends a year. Our next weekend to volunteer is July 26-27. We traditionally serve about 150 folks each day.

We also prepare and serve a meal at Opportunity House {located at 140 Lemon Street, Reading} on the 4th Thursday of each month. A dedicated group of 4 or 5 people are scheduled each month. Our next day to serve is Thursday, July 24.
